

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Q- How can I find out more information about The Lapeer Wingnuts?

A- The best way is to come out to the field either on a Saturday morning between 9:00am and noon, or a Tuesday evening between 6:00pm and dusk, weather permitting of course, and feel free to ask any questions you might have. We will be happy to answer them.

### Q- Where is the field located?

A- The flying field is located off of Davis Lake Rd. between M-24 and Millville Road. A link to a map of the field can be found on the Lapeer Wing Nuts home page.

### Q- What Church do you meet at in the off season?

A- The Trinity United Methodist Church at 1310 N. Main St. in Lapeer. It's right across the Street from the Lapeer Regional Medical Center Hospital. We meet in room 202 at 7:00pm.

### Q- What does it cost to join The Lapeer Wingnuts?

A- The annual membership fee for a junior member (age 17 and under) is \$15.00, and membership for adults is \$40.00. Well below the fees of most other flying clubs! An AMA membership is also required to fly at our, and most other clubs' fields. (current AMA membership is \$58.00 annually)

### Q- What is the AMA?

A- The AMA, or Academy of Model Aeronautics, is the official national body for model aviation in the United States. They are a self-supporting, non-profit organization whos purpose is to promote the development of model aviation as a recognized sport and worthwhile recreational activity.

### Q- Why do I have to join the AMA?

A- Your membership in the AMA provides you with liability insurance in the event that your plane is involved in some sort of mishap.
