

Lapeer Wing Nuts Field Rules

- 1) No alcohol or controlled substances on the field or any area under the Lapeer County Wing Nuts jurisdiction.
- 2) No flying over the flight line.
- 3) Upon arrival at the field, your transmitter(s) will be placed on a shelf at the radio impound shelter. When you are ready to use your radio, select the proper frequency tag, if available, and display the tag on the radio. Note: You will be responsible for replacement or repair of an aircraft that crashes because of your frequency incursion.
- 4) Pre-flight check your plane and radio before flying. (Range check, minimum 30 paces)
- 5) All flying must be done from the pilot station. Walking around the field will not be allowed.
- 6) To retrieve your aircraft from the field, you must notify other flyers that you are going out.
- 7) Dead stick landings have the right of way over powered landings.
- 8) All A.M.A. safety rules apply at the field.
- 9) Use tail stops or have an assistant hold your plane when running your airplanes engine.
- 10) No spectators allowed beyond the pit area fence.
- 11) All guests must follow all club rules and be accompanied by a club member.
- 12) A club member in good standing must accompany visitors wanting to fly. The flying non-A.M.A. member pilot is allowed (1) flight, after which they will be required to join both the A.M.A. and the Club to continue flying.
- 13) A.M.A. membership for the current year is required.
- 14) No cell phones in or near the pit area.
- 15) Spotters are required if more than 3 airplanes are in the air flying at one time.
- 16) Do not stand inline with a spinning propeller. Stand behind the propeller.
- 17) Do not taxi in the pit area. Start and carry your plane to the flight line. Stop engine at flight line and carry plane to return to pit.
